## **UNIVERSITY OF MAINE SYSTEM TRUSTEES TO MEET SEPTEMBER 14-15 IN ORONO**

BANGOR—The University of Maine System Board of Trustees will meet at the University of Maine in Orono on September 14-15. The meeting will be held in the new Wells Common Conference Center.

Trustees will consider and act on several items, including:

- proposed expansion of UMaine Advanced Engineered Wood Composite Center and renovations to UMFK's Powers Hall
- the University System's biennium budget request for 2010-11
- a new Master of Fine Arts in Intermedia (Studio) at UMaine

Established in 1968, the University of Maine System is the state's largest educational enterprise. It has an annual enrollment of more than 45,000 students. It features seven universities – some with multiple campuses – located across the state, as well as 10 University College outreach centers, a law school, and an additional 75 interactive distance learning sites.
