BANGOR—Financial matters will be the major topics of discussion when the University of Maine System Board of Trustees meets on Nov. 16-17 in Farmington.

The meeting will be held at the University of Maine at Farmington's Olsen Student Center.

Key agenda items include:

- Presentation and discussion of the university system's audited financial report for Fiscal Year 2008, which ended on June 30
- A presentation of a status report on finances for the current fiscal year (FY09)
- Discussion and action on a proposed capital improvements bond request
